Composition of the Board of Directors

The board of directors as of January 2010 is comprised of 3 directors.

Policy of the company is to keep the board at a compact size to enhance and simplify the decision making process, particularly as the board is required to meet by electronic means so as to permit for rapid response to events on behalf of the directors.

Election of Directors

The Board is elected at the Annual General Meeting of the shareholders of the company.

Directors form a board which is elected for a term of 3 years, exception for election of an interim member who completes the term of the member that is being replaced.

The Chairman of the Board of Board of Directors is also elected directly by the Annual General Meeting of the shareholders of the company. However, the Chairman has the right to select the Vice Chairman from among the board, and on an ad hoc basis as may be required.

Remuneration of Directors

Each member of a company within the Belarms Group of Companies is enetitled to remuneration. Payment of a remuneration to a director is made up a director's fee and travel supplement. Generally, payment of fees begins in the year
